Grand Valley State University Prescribed Fire Courses

January 12-14, 19-21, 2018

NRM/BIO 380 Introduction to Wildland and Prescribed Fire Management

Taught by Todd Aschenbach (GVSU) and a team of instructors from the DNR and Michigan Prescribed Fire Council. This 1 week intensive course provides students with a basic introduction to wildland and prescribed fire ecology, behavior, and management. Required training for all personnel seeking to become Wildland Firefighters under National Wildfire Coordinating Group (NWCG) certification standards. NWCG certifications in S-130, S-190, L-180, and I-100 granted upon successful course completion for first series.
